How to interlink the e-Tendering Transition-IN activities with the rest of OpenPEPPOL

Brussels 20th March 2018

Set – up and links to collaboration with OpenPEPPOL

Starting point: eSens “package” handed over to OpenPEPPOL.



E-Transition WG- what they do: specs, policy, requirements to security and trust.

They need to collaborate in getting ready for production.

The role of Operations is to provide test beds for onboarding for the eDelivery part and to provide certificates for eDelivery as they administrate trust list if needed and to sign also agreements.

eDelivery: they maintain and further develop the AS 4 profiles and Pracc as such they define other specs than the ones handed over and they further maintain handover specs when publish as Peppol specs.

More interlinks

- All access providers they have to be members of eDelivery community (where transport profiles are developed and maintained).
- eDelivery will be handled , but will take into consideration as the top of the list of policy (no pre award and post award eDelivery) specs requirements . To identify /structure – how to handle still to be decided.
- **Main interlink:** in the revised structure the Operations is setting up professional support virtual team.–
- eTendering can use Operations and ask for support, but not to participate as project team.

Roles & timing (1/2)

- Lefteris Leontaridis as operations manager will be responsible for setting up the eTendering Authority.
- Smp providers in order to operate that will be a centralized testbed , for self testing : will be implemented in the third quarter of 2018. They need to pass the test.
- Pki migration –by September to issue (run with two certifications) and by the end of November recognized only one certificate – pushing before eTendering is going into production.
- Regarding the LOU about As4, a taskforce has been set up in order to cater (by Summer 2018) and enable the implementation – usage measure will be mandatory : Anna-Lis Berg is the reference person appointed by the MC to honor the agreement with eTendering.
- Any requirements to change must be put in the change management process, eDelivery team, will collaborate with EC to ensure the implementation of their requirements .

Roles & timing (2/2)

EC has also agreed on compliance tests of software AS4 – which is s not test for certificates and will interlink the two processes.

Dedicated resources from OpenPEPPOL : We are enforcing our Operations's capability to support better the implementation in continuous on boarding of AS 4 Access Points and based on the dual layers agreement structure.
