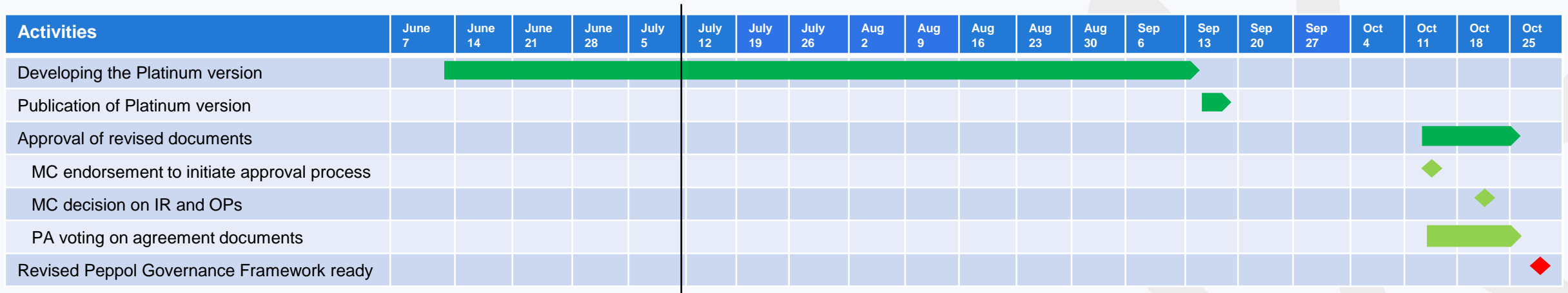
Progression of work (as per July 12)

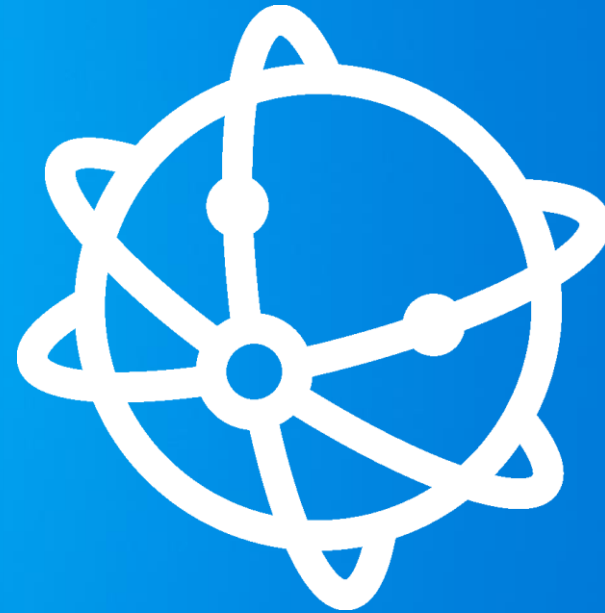
A total of 700 comments received

- 472 comments (85%) for resolution/clarification discussed
 - 254 concluded with no change to the draft documents (54%)
 - 17 comments noted for further legal consultation on 4 different topics
- 86 comments still open for discussion
 - 56 related to End User reporting
- 121 comments classified as editorial
 - will be addressed by appointed document editor
- 21 comments classified as not part of MVP
 - for backlog, issues register or out of scope)

Timeline for completing the ARTF deliverables

- Falling behind original schedule
 - Work on End User reporting will continue over the European summer period
 - Expect revised ARTF deliverables to be available mid-September
- The decision process follows the current governance process as outlined in the TIA and Statutes
 - The revised agreement documents are subject to a formal vote amongst the PAs
 - The IR and OPs will be approved by the MC
- Migration planning is not part of the ARTF work and will be prepared as a separate activity within the OO.
