## eDelivery Domain Community Leader Candidacy Motivation Letter

Dear OpenPeppol Members,

The eDelivery Community (eDEC) is an important forum for Peppol members to collaborate for the seamless operation and growth of the e-Delivery network.

As the responsible senior executive officer for the Australian Peppol Authority, I am invested in ensuring the success of Peppol. I want to not only ensure stability and sustainability of the network, but also to focus on the innovation and changes needed to ensure Peppol meets the needs of its growing participants and users, now and into the future. By doing so, I aim to ensure that Peppol is well positioned to continue to be the preeminent framework, making it the best choice for countries, Service Providers and End Users, so that it continues to expand its reach globally.

- International Invoicing – implement eDelivery domain changes needed to support Peppol International Invoicing (PINT), including supporting a Proof-of-Concept exercise. PINT is important to ensuring Peppol remains at the forefront of eInvoicing and continues to be an attractive proposition for countries to achieve global interoperability.
- New reporting mechanism – support the development of a reporting mechanism to implement the new reporting policy as part of the new Peppol Agreement framework.
- Global collaboration – support discussions on the Global Interoperability Framework (GIF) and with European E-Invoicing Service Providers Association (EESPA).
- Global developments – it is important to follow global developments (e.g. the Business Payment Coalition market pilot in the U.S.) to ensure Peppol remains the framework of choice.

I will bring my experience in shaping and leading large-scale, complex IT changes and transformational programs of work to identify, facilitate and embed change and innovation to improve the operation of the eDelivery network. As a strategic leader, and strong collaborator, I will work cohesively with peers and stakeholders to deliver pragmatic solutions and create strong governance frameworks and support processes to ensure the continued success of change initiatives.

I believe I can bring this experience to the Peppol eDEC to help the network continue to grow and prosper for all its members and users.
