4 Professional relationship of Candidate and Proposing Member: I have been working as Country Manager for B2Brouter in Germany since 2018 and B2Brouter is increasingly involved in the implementation of PEPPOL processes and infrastructures for the Pre-Award. I started to work for B2Brouter as secondary occupation while being employed at the University of Koblenz. Since January 2023 I continue the work with B2Brouter as freelancer and independent consultant.

6 Motivation letter, outlining the Candidate's vision for the position(s), for which the Candidate is running.

I am convinced that the pre-award area will become increasingly important in the future. The current situation, where suppliers have to register on a multitude of public procurement and tendering platforms and find their way around menu navigation and interface designs, creates high entry barriers, especially for SMEs, which are considered to be particularly innovative, and causes high process costs. The consequence of this situation is that fewer tenders are submitted and there is little competition, which can ultimately lead to expensive procurements. The establishment of Peppol specifications to interconnect procurement systems that are targeted toward the needs of suppliers and buyers creates real added value for the actors concerned and offers the opportunity to establish new business models for IT service providers. Peppol enabled pre-award processes ensure easier access to foreign markets for all actors as well as a high degree of comparability and transparency through a high degree of structuring of procurement processes.

Initiatives such as eForms and ESPD will boost the pre-award area in the upcoming years, but they are only a few essential building blocks in the overall process. The Peppol pre-award community has built up a large knowledge base in recent years and has developed several specifications that will be important for shaping the future design of pre-award procurement in the European context. As we move forward, it will be necessary to further complete these developments, to consolidate them in an appropriate manner, but also to link more closely to existing initiatives such as CEN TC 440, eForms and ESPD. I would like to support the Pre-Award Community CMB in following this path. As an active member of the pre-award community for many years, and in my role as co-coordination of the WG "Peppol BIS Complete Tendering Procedure" and my involvement in various projects in the area of pre-award, I strongly believe

that I can contribute my knowledge well and support the CMB in the upcoming decisions and the tasks to be carried out during the next two years.
