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1 Introduction

1.1 Notification to Members

The Secretary General of OpenPeppol, on behalf of the Managing Committee, hereby invites all members to participate at the 16th OpenPeppol General Assembly, hereinafter referred to as GA16. The meeting will be held on November 8th, 2023 and will be conducted entirely online, without physical presence of members. The Bureau (Secretary General, Scrutineer and Minute Taker) will be physically present at the designated location in Brussels (BOSA, WTC III, Boulevard Simon Bolivar 30, 1000 Brussels, Belgium).

The sole purpose of GA16 is to approve the new Statutes of the Association.

Since January 1st, 2020, the new Belgian Code of Companies and Associations (BCCA) has entered into force, requiring all legal entities governed by the BCCA, including international not-for-profit organisations (i.e. AISBL) such as OpenPeppol, to amend their articles of association accordingly, by January 1st, 2024.

In this context, the Statutes of OpenPeppol must be amended in line with the BCCA, in order to comply with Belgian Law.

During the last General Assembly (GA15), the vote for the approval of the new Statutes could not take place, as we did not reach the required quorum (50%+1) of 252 members with voting rights. Therefore, a second General Assembly is required, where no quorum is needed, according to the current OpenPeppol Statutes (Article 17).

3 Participation procedures

The following terms and conditions apply to the 16th OpenPeppol General Assembly:

- 1. <u>Meeting format:</u> The 16th General Assembly will be conducted on **November 8**th, **2023** entirely online, without physical presence of members.
- 2. <u>Eligibility:</u> All Members admitted at present and until **November 3**rd, **2023** are eligible to participate and vote. Observers can attend and follow the proceedings but cannot vote.
- 3. **Registration:** In order to participate, members must send the designated **Registration Form**, which is distributed together with the present Invitation.
 - a. For a registration to be valid, the Registration Form must be completed and returned to ga@peppol.eu, no later than November 3rd, 2023.
 - b. No member can participate and vote at the General Assembly without the submission of a Registration Form.
 - c. Only one person per member organisation should have the right to vote on its behalf at the General Assembly.
 - d. More than one person per member can attend the General Assembly, given that they submit a separate Registration Form.



- 4. <u>How to Participate Directly:</u> Registered participants will receive a **link** to access the online meeting at the scheduled time, together with instructions on how to connect, and how to raise their questions and participate in the meeting.
 - These practicalities will also be discussed during the Q&A session referred to below in point 4 "Further Information and Questions".
- 5. How to Participate through a Valid Representative (Proxy): A member that cannot have a designated representative from within their organisation attend the General Assembly online may be validly represented by another member organisation that will act as its Proxy and vote on its behalf.

To be validly represented by a Proxy in the General Assembly, a member must complete and send to OpenPeppol the designated **Proxy Delegation Form**, which is distributed together with the present invitation.

For a Proxy delegation to be valid, the **Proxy Delegation Form** must be completed and returned to **ga@peppol.eu**, **no later than November 3rd**, **2023**.
