Main developments since last meeting

- ▶▶ Implementation of revised statutes approved in GA10, based on governance model approved in GA9, from the upcoming GA11
- ▶▶ Agreement to make support for the PEPPOL AS4 profile mandatory in the PEPPOL eDelivery Network from 1 February 2020
- ▶▶ Agreement on the conceptual model for the revised PEPPOL Agreement Framework
 - ▶▶ Update of Annex 1, 3 and 4 in the existing TIA
- ▶▶ Germany mandates use of PEPPOL eDelivery Network for e-invoicing to the public sector at federal and regional level (if webservice is used)
- ▶▶ PEPPOL based Nationwide e-invoicing framework launched in Singapore
- ▶▶ Australia and New Zealand announce transition to PEPPOL for eInvoicing, by end of 2019
- ▶▶ Substantial growth in usage of the PEPPOL eDelivery Network and in OpenPEPPOL membership

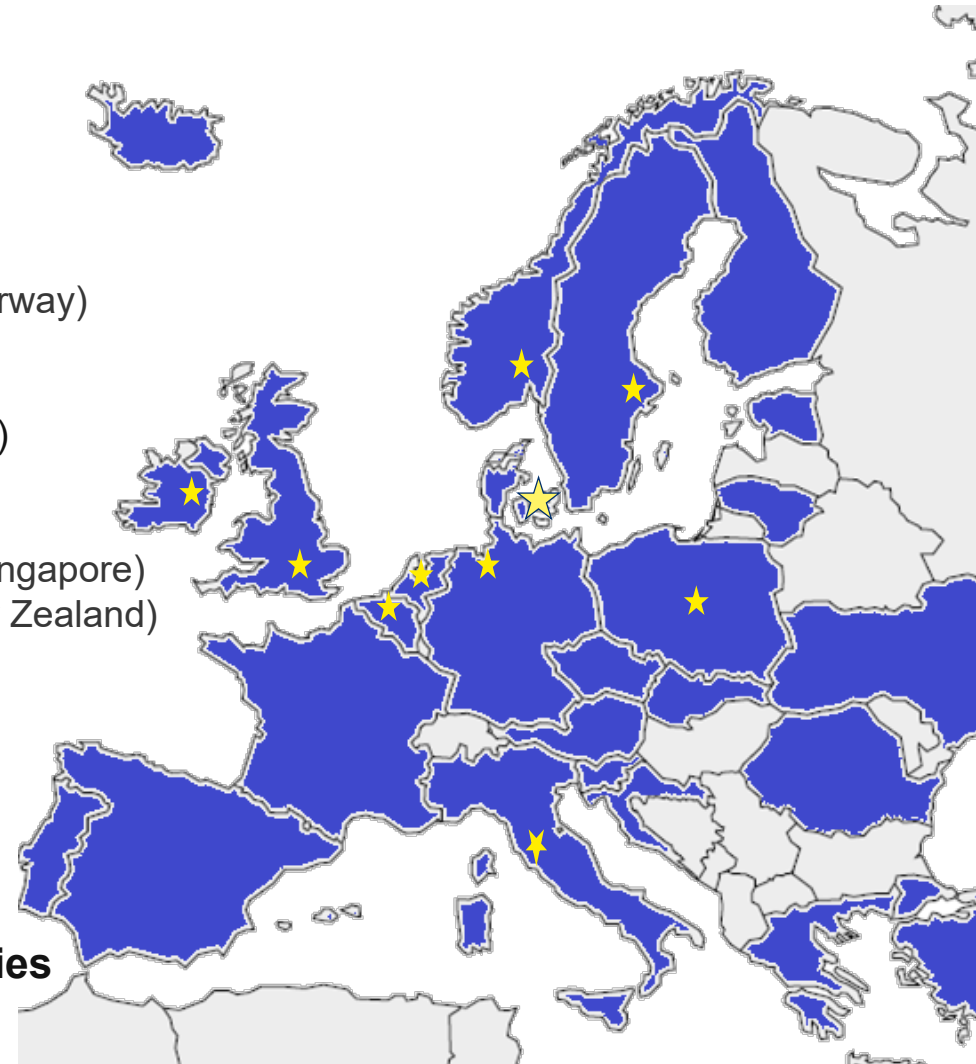

Main priorities – external

- ▶▶ Roll-out of PEPPOL BIS Billing 3.0 throughout Europe supporting implementation of Directive 2014/55/EU by April 2019 and beyond
- ▶▶ Develop an international PEPPOL BIS Billing version to support Non-European tax regimes
- ▶▶ Support global implementation and growth for the PEPPOL Interoperability Framework
- ▶▶ Increased use of PEPPOL BIS for catalogue, order/order confirmation, despatch advice and invoice response messages
- ▶▶ Finalise the new PEPPOL Agreement Framework
- ▶▶ Increased use of PEPPOL BIS in Pre-Award processes supporting implementation of Directive 2014/24/EU
- ▶▶ Assess and include new domains for use of the PEPPOL eDelivery network

Main priorities – internal

- ▶▶ Implement the new governance structure and Statutes adopted by GA9 and GA10
 - ▶▶ Delegation and Escalation framework providing checks and balances through Internal Regulations
 - ▶▶ Support the OpenPEPPOL bodies in establishing new and revised routines
- ▶▶ Follow-up on Letter of Understanding with the European Commission – AS4 implementation
- ▶▶ Support the development of the new PEPPOL Agreement Framework
- ▶▶ Strengthen the Association’s capacity to support Members through an expanded and improved Service Desk and on-boarding procedures using the new Testbed facility
- ▶▶ Increase the availability of resources to the Communities for technical tasks
- ▶▶ Improve the internal workflow and communication tools and procedures
- ▶▶ Re-branding of PEPPOL (pending MC approval)

More than 70 members (included pre-award service providers)

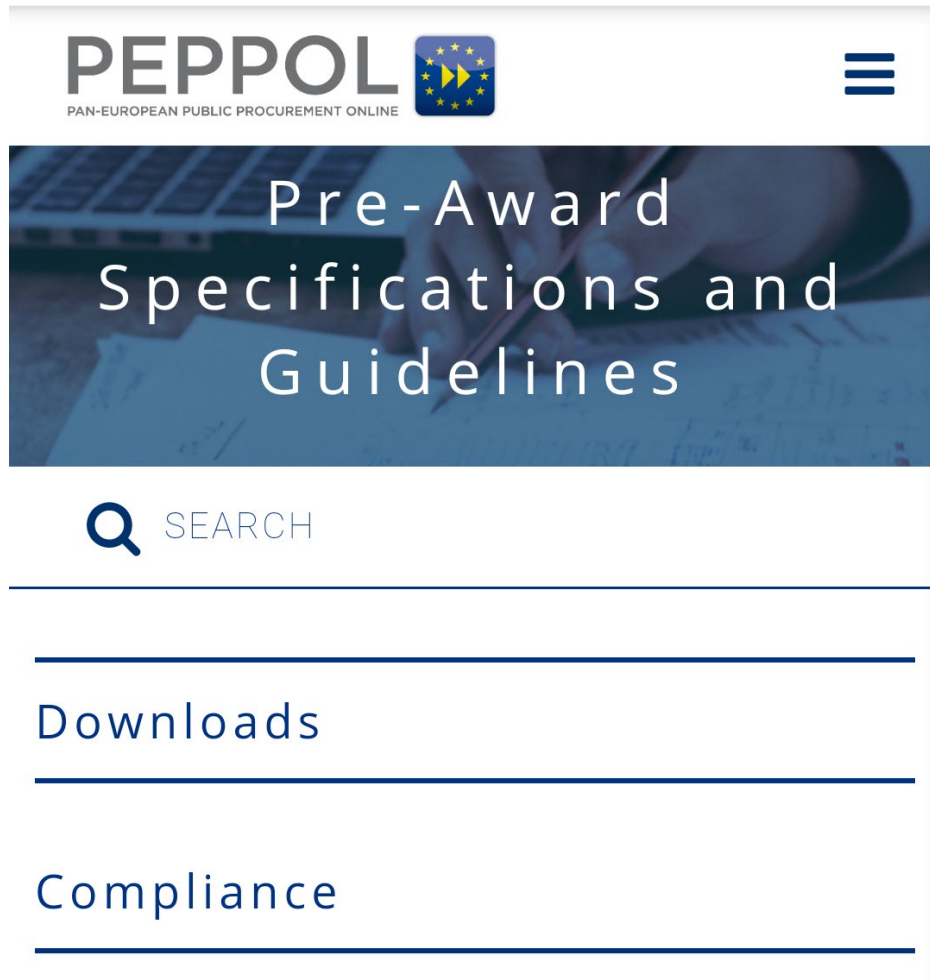
Activities completed and under way

- **Implementation of the Governance model** (rules, service agreements) taking into account the requirements of eTendering and the Pre-Award transactions involved, also by transferring to the revision work on Framework Agreement business model, new roles and membership e-Delivery usage and service levels requirements;

eDelivery Community 2018

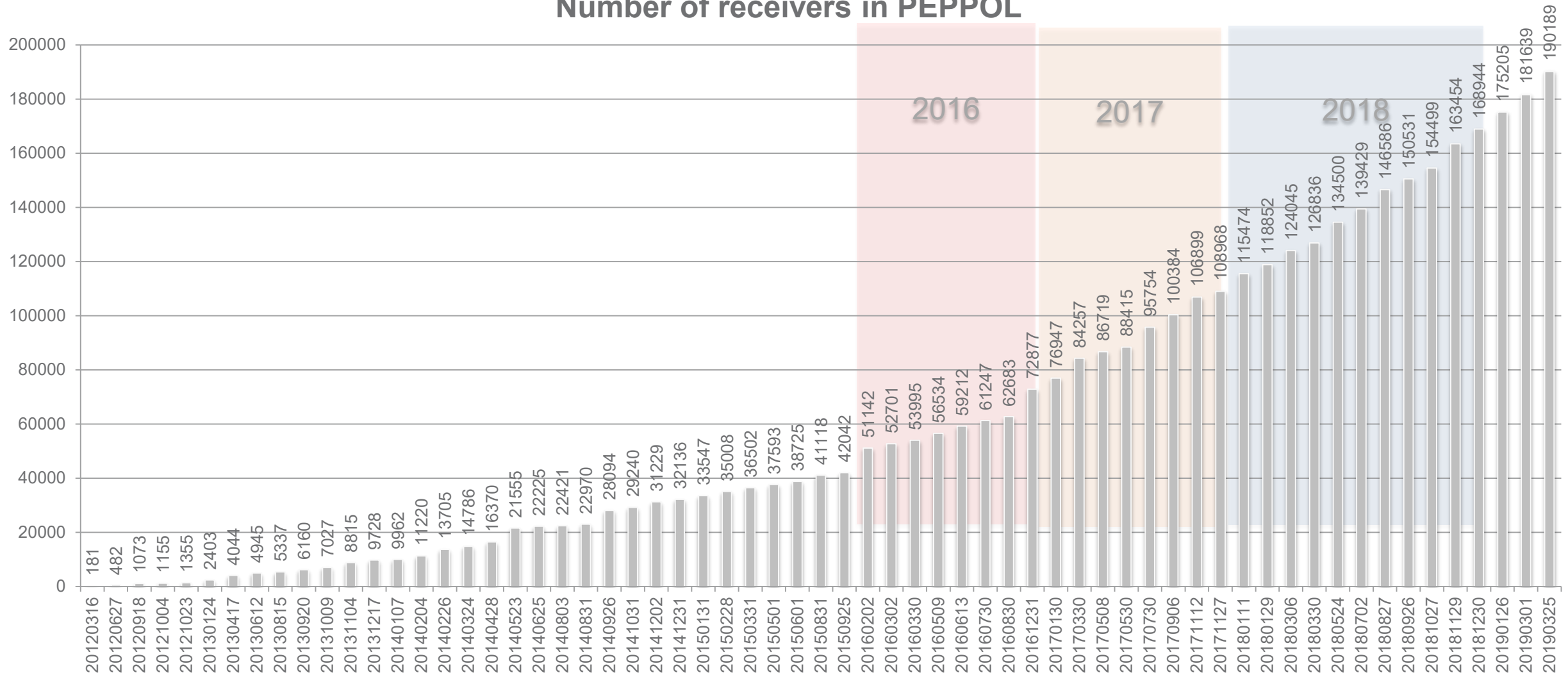
- ▶▶ PKI migration for APs and SMPs (v.2→v.3)
- ▶▶ Testbed for AP onboarding
- ▶▶ PEPPOL AS4 profile v.2 (aligned with the CEF profile)
- ▶▶ PEPPOL AS2 Profile
 - ▶▶ v.1.2 (added attributes)
 - ▶▶ V.2 (sha256, replace RFC2616 with RFC7230-RFC7235 to allow for more modern libraries and services)
- ▶▶ PEPPOL Envelope (SBDH) v.1.2 (added attributes, support for non-XML payloads)
- ▶▶ Transport Security Policy v.1.0 (SSL certificates)
- ▶▶ Code list updates (documents, processes)

PEPPOL eDelivery Network

- ▶▶ The number of registered receivers in the SML increased 54% to 170.000 in 2018. As of March 25 2019 there are 190.200 registered receivers.
- ▶▶ Norway still leading but their share has decreased (from 85% to 78% in 2018)
- ▶▶ The number of receivers outside Norway increases w. 3-4% per month

2018 – accomplishments

- ▶▶ Upgraded all other BIS messages to version 3.0
- ▶▶ Aligned with BIS Billing 3.0
- ▶▶ Supporting latest requirement on price structure, etc.
- ▶▶ Successfully strengthened the PEPPOL-network
- ▶▶ Resolved more than 100 RFC:s in 2 releases
- ▶▶ Implemented supplier country specific validation rules for Italy, Sweden, Denmark and Norway
- ▶▶ Assisted Singapore in creating a national BIS Billing 3.0 extension and at the same time collected requirements for international usage
- ▶▶ Further improved our development and test process for the spring and fall release
- ▶▶ Refined the methodology for country rules.

2019 – plans

- ▶▶ Deliver new BIS Catalogue without response
- ▶▶ Continue to improve the PEPPOL BIS messages thereby strengthening the stability and functionality in the network
- ▶▶ Deliver a Core Invoice Message Response in collaboration with EESPA thereby increasing level of standardization both inside and outside the PEPPOL-network when it comes to invoice processing functionality and support for e.g. supply chain financing in the PEPPOL-network
- ▶▶ Initiate a new POACC work group performing a pre-study on usage of BIS Billing outside EU/EEA
 - ▶▶ Thereby preparing PEPPOL for going global
 - ▶▶ Preparing PEPPOL for eInvoicing requirements from EU/EEA public sector entities also on non-EU/EEA suppliers of goods and services
- ▶▶ 2 releases – spring- and fall release
- ▶▶ Explore interest for proposed work group BIS advanced ordering

Summary

2018

- ▶▶ Made PEPPOL ready for being the natural choice for European public sector to live up to the eInvoicing Directive
- ▶▶ Took some major steps in preparing PEPPOL for becoming a global player in eInvoicing

2019

- ▶▶ Continue to develop and improve the OpenPEPPOL BIS messages
- ▶▶ Continue to be the implementation body for e-procurement standards
- ▶▶ Develop support for international invoicing through the PEPPOL network
